Regulations for Club Competitions and Trophies

- For all season long competitions (e.g., BAR, RR Championships etc) performances achieved in events that clash with club-organised events will not qualify. This is to ensure that members who help with club promotions are not disadvantaged.
- 2. Only 1st claim members are eligible for club competitions and awards.
- 3. Time Trials Qualifying rides for all season long TT competitions must be achieved in open, semi-open association and WVCC club events on Manchester DC, Liverpool DC, North DC or Midlands DC (J, D, K & L)
- 4. Only if no member has qualifying times in these districts, will rides in other CTT districts count.
- 5. If a trophy is not won, 'Not Awarded' is to be engraved after the year on the plinth base or cartouche.

6 TIME TRIAL

RAPHA CUP. Awarded to the rider achieving the fastest first year 25 Mile TT.

FORSTER CUP (presented by ICI) Senior Best All Rounder. Awarded to the male rider who has the best average speed over 25, 50 and 100 miles.

GOLDEN WONDER TROPHY (presented by Golden Wonder Ltd) Junior Best All Rounder. Awarded to the male rider classified under RTTC rules as a junior, with the best average speed over two 10 mile and two 25 mile time trials. TBC: - Awarded to the female rider classified under RTTC rules as a junior, with the best average speed over two 10 mile and two 25 mile time trials.

CARETAKER TROPHY Veterans Best All Rounder Awarded to the male or female rider over 40 years of age with the best plus on club veterans standards over two 25 mile and two 50 mile time trials.

KNOWSLEY PIPE BOWL Ladies Best All Rounder. Awarded to the female lady rider who has the best average speed over 10, 25 and 50 miles.

GUARDIAN CUP (presented by the Guardian Series Newspapers). Awarded to the male or female rider totalling the most points on handicap, in the season long series of club 10mile time trials. Points are scored based on 25 for 1st handicap, reducing to 1 point for 25th place. A rider's best 5 rides count, and points are totalled to give the final score.

Scratch Cup: - Awarded to the male or female rider totalling the most points on actual placing in the season long series of club 10-mile time trials. Points are scored based on 25 for 1st reducing to 1 point for 25th place. A rider's best 5 rides count, and points are totalled to give the final score.

The Road Bike Challenge: - Awarded to the male or female rider totalling the most points whilst competing on a road bike in the summer 10-mile TT series. This is a cumulative total over all counting events, 25 points for 1st place reducing to 1 point for 25th place. Definition of a road bike is NO clip on or fixed Tri Bars and/or NO wheel rims deeper than 65mm [inc Disc Rear Wheel] and/or NO helmet covering the ears.

ALF STYLES MEMORIAL TROPHY (presented by Mr & Mrs J Hibbert). Awarded to the male winner of the club 10 mile time trial championship.

WVCC Women's 10mile TT trophy. Awarded to the winner of the club Women's 10mile time trial championship.

DALLAM CUP. Awarded to the male winner of the club hill climb championship. WVCC Women's Hill Climb Trophy. Awarded to the winner of the club Women's hill climb championship.

BILL HAYES CUP (presented by Bill Hayes). Awarded to the winner of the Men's club 25 mile time trial championship.

WVCC Women's 25mile TT trophy. Awarded to the winner of the club Women's 25mile time trial championship.

ASKEW CUP (presented by Bob Baillie). Awarded to the male winner of the club 50mile time trial championship.

WVCC Women's 50mile TT trophy. Awarded to the winner of the club Women's 50mile time trial championship.

Alan Littlemore 100 MILE CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY. Awarded to the male winner of the club 100 mile time trial championship.

WVCC Women's 100mile TT trophy. Awarded to the winner of the club Women's 100mile time trial championship.

GOLDBOURNE CUP (presented by Mike Johnson). Awarded to the male winner of the club 12 hour time trial championship. Tricycles are eligible and are allowed +8% on their mileage.

NOT YET PURCHASED: - Awarded to the winner of the club Women's 12-hour time trial championship. Tricycles are eligible and are allowed +8% on their mileage.

COUPE DE LA VILLE DE BORDEAUX (presented by Ron Sant and Ian Hilditch). Awarded to the male winner of the club 24-hour time trial championship.

NOT YET PURCHASED: - Awarded to the winner of the club Women's 24-hour time trial championship.

TIME TRIAL STANDARDS. Claims must be made to the Time Trial Secretary on an official form and must be received by 31st October of the current racing season, accompanied by proof of result. Details of standards available are listed on the club website.

7 OFF ROAD

Competitions and trophies are as follows:

EVA DITCHFIELD TROPHY (presented by Bill Newby). Awarded to the rider with the best performance in cyclo-cross (in the previous season) (Usually the best performance in the club's event)

MOUNTAIN BIKE TROPHY. Awarded to the rider with the best performance in mountain bike races.

8 ROAD and TRACK RACING

Competitions and trophy details are as follows:

SENIOR ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP (presented by Golden Wonder Ltd). Awarded to the male member rider recording the most points in BCF events. Consideration will be given to the events category and status.

Women's RR Cup - Awarded to the female rider recording the most points in BCF events. Consideration will be given to the events category and status.

JUNIOR ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP (presented by Bob Malam). Awarded to the rider currently junior under BCF rules, who scores the most points in BCF events. Consideration will be given to the events category and status. Open to male and female members

JUVENILE ROAD RACE CHAMPIONSHIP (presented by Barratt Homes Ltd). Awarded to the rider currently a juvenile under BCF rules, who scores the most points in BCF events. Consideration will be given to the events category and status. Open to male and female members

LEAGUE OF VETERAN RACING CYCLISTS' TROPHY. Awarded to the male or female member with the best performances in LVRC races.

THE LEAGUE INTERNATIONAL TROPHY. Awarded to the male or female member with the best performances in TLI races.

[Where there is lack of clarity in result due to age group, quality and/or size of field. The following should be used:-Races should be considered the same as BC Regional B events where points are awarded as follows: 15 for 1st place 12,10,8,6,5,4,3,2,1 for 10th place. Those points are to be applied to the placings in age group/category. [if known] The relevant totals will determine the final order.]

TRACK CHAMPION awarded to member with the most points in a season long track league or the winner of a specific event [to be decided by committee in consultation with BC Secretary]

9 GENERAL AWARDS

ALAN SHORT CLUB PERSON OF THE YEAR [presented by Mr & Mrs Short] Awarded to the member who in the opinion of the committee has supported the club the most in the calendar year

HORSEFIELD TROPHY (presented by Julia Johnson). Awarded annually to the female member who has given the most help to the club in the previous twelve months either competitively or in any other way. Awarded by committee decision.

JACK GEE NOVICE TROPHY (presented by Jack Gee). Awarded by committee decision for the best achievement by a member in any aspect of cycling for which he/she was a novice during the year.

ATTENDANCE SHIELD. Awarded to the member who attends the most club runs between successive AGMs. Records are kept by the Runs Captain.

ROEVIN LTD CUP. Awarded to the winner of the club Freewheel championship

TOURIST SHIELD. Awarded by committee decision to the person who has ridden in the most diverse locations, completed the most touring or audax miles in the calendar year.

WOBBLY WHEEL: - awarded to the member who has fallen off with the most style in the calendar year. Awarded by committee decision.

HALF WHEEL TROPHY [presented by Jim Williams]:- Awarded to the person who has half wheeled prolifically in the calendar year. Award cannot be won in two consecutive years by the same person. Nominees can be made by club membership but awarded by committee decision.

10 CLUB RECORDS

Club records are recognised on courses in any district and awards made at the discretion of the committee.

11 CHAMPIONSHIP MEDALS

Awarded as follows:

Gold, silver and bronze will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd fastest male and female riders in the 10, 25, 50, 100 mile, 12 & 24 hour time trial championships.

Gold, silver, and bronze will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd male and female riders in the cyclo-cross, hill climb and MTB championships.

Gold, silver and bronze will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd riders in the Senior, Junior, Veteran and Ladies BARs.

Gold, silver and bronze will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd riders in the Senior, Junior, Juvenile, LVRC and TLI , Road Race Championships.

Individual awards are not currently made to Junior or Juvenile riders for TT championships.
